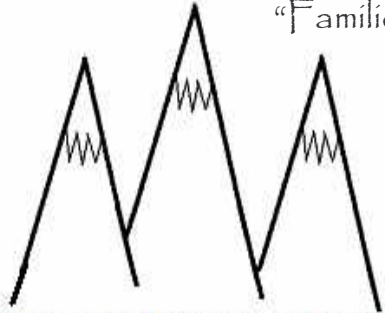
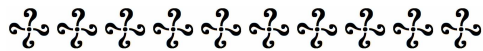

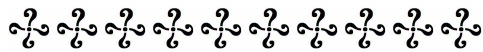

Bible Focus Luke 6:17-26

17He went down with them and stood on a level place. A large crowd of his disciples was there and a great number of people from all over Judea, from Jerusalem, and from the coast of Tyre and Sidon, 18who had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases. Those troubled by evil spirits were cured, 19and the people all tried to touch him, because power was coming from him and healing them all. 20Looking at his disciples, he said: "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God. 21Blessed are you who hunger now, for you will be satisfied. Blessed are you who cry now, for you will laugh. 22Blessed are you when men hate you, when they exclude you and insult you and reject your name as evil, because of the Son of Man. 23"Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, because great is your reward in heaven. For that is how their fathers treated the prophets. 24"But woe to you who are rich, for you have already received your comfort. 25Woe to you who are well fed now, for you will go hungry. Woe to you who laugh now, for you will mourn and weep. 26Woe to you when all men speak well of you, for that is how their fathers treated the false prophets.

1. What four groups of people did Jesus call blessed?

3. When do you think those whom Jesus called blessed will get their rewards?
4. What four groups of people did Jesus say would have "woes?"
5. If you were a rich person who heard Jesus talking on the Mountain, how would you feel? What would you think?
6. Do you usually think that being called rich, famous, or being someone who laughs is a bad thing?
7. Do you usually think that being called poor or hungry or even hated by everyone is a good thing?
8. JESUS called all of these things GOOD! Go figure! Being a person in this world means that sometimes bad things or hurtful things happen to us. Being a Christian in this world almost promises us that we will hurt sometimes. JESUS tells us that He loves us and remembers us when we are SAD or HURTING.
