1. What did Jesus say to the Samaritan woman?
2. Why was the Samaritan woman surprised that he would ask this?
3. What did Jesus tell the woman he could give her?
4. The woman asks Jesus for this water – she doesn't want to have to keep coming to the well to draw water. When she asks Jesus for this water, Jesus replies curiously. What does he tell the woman to do?
5. What does Jesus know about this woman?
6. Jesus tells the Samaritan woman that he is the Messiah. What does the Samaritan woman say when she goes back into her town?
7. Jesus stayed for two days with the Samaritans. Many of them began to believe in him. Why did they say that they were able to believe?
