In the Gospel, Jesus is called "Lamb of God" and "Rabbi," "Messiah," and "Christ." What other names or titles do we give Jesus? Brainstorm and make a list together!



**Bible Focus John 1:29-42**

29The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! 30This is the one I meant when I said, 'A man who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.' 31I myself did not know him, but the reason I came baptizing with water was that he might be revealed to Israel." 32Then John gave this testimony: "I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and remain on him. 33I would not have known him, except that the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, 'The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is he who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.' 34I have seen and I testify that this is the Son of God." 35The next day John was there again with two of his disciples. 36When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, "Look, the Lamb of God!"

37When the two disciples heard him say this, they followed Jesus. 38Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, "What do you want?" They said, "Rabbi" (which means Teacher), "where are you staying?" 39"Come," he replied, "and you will see." So they went and saw where he was staying, and spent that day with him. It was about the tenth hour. 40Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus. 41The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, "We have found the Messiah" (that is, the Christ). 42And he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon son of John. You will be called Cephas" (which, when translated, is Peter).

1. What did John say that Jesus did as the Lamb of God?
2. What are the sins of the world?
3. When Jesus walked by, John called Jesus the Lamb of God. People heard them and followed Jesus. Where did they go?
4. What does it mean to follow Jesus?
5. After spending time with Jesus, what was the first thing Andrew did?
6. Be like Andrew! Think of a person your family could bring to church.



When Jesus looked at Peter, He immediately knew who he was. However, he didn't let Peter stay that way for long! Instead, he gave Peter a new name. Jesus called Peter CEPHAS which means ROCK. As a family come up with a new name for each person at your table. (You might decide to keep your name and add a description – for example: "Robert the Faithful." OR You might decide to come up with an object name like "Peter the ROCK.")
