Leadership Pathways is the Christian leadership training event for youth in our synod. Unlike LYO assemblies and retreats, **Leadership Pathways** is not designed for every youth. Instead, you are asked to nominate youth in your congregation with the greatest leadership potential. Youth should be in grades 9-12 at the time of application.

Our hope is that youth selected to participate in this event will then utilize this training in their local congregations. Therefore, we ask that youth be able to identify specific ways they intend to use skills learned at the event. Likewise, we ask that churches be prepared to use these youth in ways that encourage their leadership skills to mature.

This year's event will be held at Lenoir-Rhyne University on June 21-25. Due to budget constraints, there is no longer a subsidy provided by the Synod LYNC Network budget and therefore, the cost to each participant is \$215.00. Congregations are encouraged to help youth cover this part of their expenses. Please note the application deadline of MARCH 31, 2010.

Thank you for taking time to nominate youth from your congregation for this event. We always appreciate the support Youth Ministry receives from our church professionals. We ask that you keep this event, as well as all programs of the synod, in your prayers.
