

# The Table Salt Devos

***"Adding flavor and preserving tradition at the Family Table on the week of Mar 9th"***

Bible Focus: John 11:1-45

Because this passage is so long, you are invited to read this passage from your own Bible. As you do this, here is your task:

- Underline anything that Martha says in green
- Whenever you see the name "Jesus" underline the verb that follows His name. We're going to examine what Jesus *does* in this passage. (example: Jesus said or Jesus found).

In the space below, write all the verbs that you see Jesus doing:

Share your **HIGHS**



and **LOWS!**



*Whose death have you experienced? Think of a person or animal who has died. Share the name of this special person/animal and one word that describes how you felt when this happened.*



1. *Who is sick? What do this man's sisters say to Jesus?*
2. *On the way back to Judea, Jesus tells his disciples that Lazarus "has fallen asleep." The disciples misunderstand. They think Lazarus is napping – but Jesus tells them that he is dead. When Jesus arrived, how long had Lazarus been dead?*
3. *Re-read John 11:21-27 and pay careful attention to what Martha says. In this passage, what does Jesus say that He is?*
4. *What does Mary do when she sees Jesus? What does Jesus do?*
5. *What does Jesus say in His prayer to the father? What happens to Lazarus?*

## **FAMILY CHALLENGE**

The disciples and many Jews who saw Lazarus be raised from the dead began to believe in Jesus. The Bible that they "put their faith in him." We may not have seen someone raised from the dead, but we too have experienced miracles. Make a list of the miracles that your family has experienced, and thank God for these things that point to the power, majesty and love of God.
