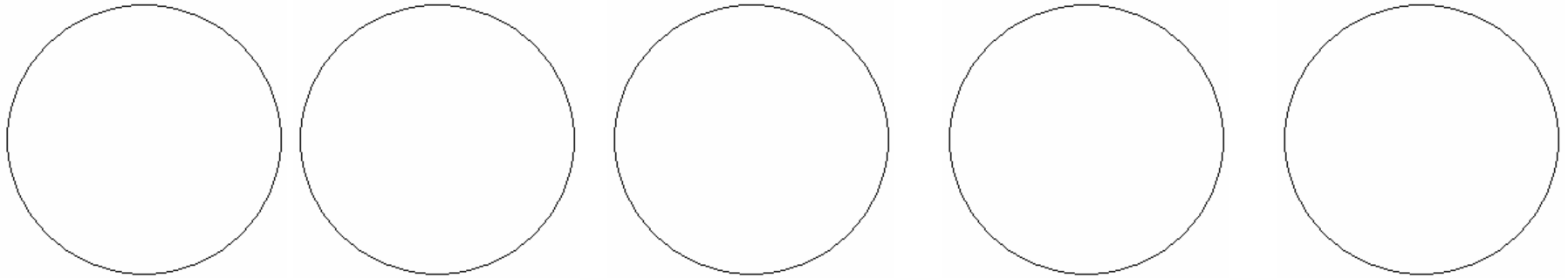

she provides food for her family
and portions for her servant girls.

her arms are strong for her tasks.

and extends her hands to the needy.
