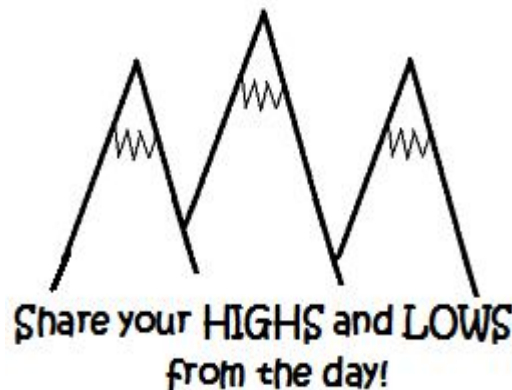


# THE FAMILY TABLE DEVOS

## BIBLE FOCUS: Psalm 25:1-7

- 1 To you, O LORD, I lift up my soul;  
2 In you, I trust, O my God.  
Do not let me be put to shame,  
Nor let my enemies triumph over me.  
3 No one whose hope is in you  
Will ever be put to shame,  
But they will be put to shame  
Who are treacherous and without excuse.  
4 **Show me your ways, O LORD,  
Teach me your paths;**  
5 **Guide me in your truth and teach me,  
For you are God my Savior,  
And my hope is in you all day long.**  
6 Remember, O LORD, your great mercy and love  
For they are from of old.  
7 Remember not the sins of my youth  
And my rebellious ways;  
According to your love remember me,  
For you are good, O LORD.
