Bible Focus Luke 17:11-17
11Now on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. **12**As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance **13**and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" **14**When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed. **15**One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. **16**He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan. **17**Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? **18**Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" **19**Then he said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well."

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Close with the Alphabet Prayer. Each person will go around in a circle and say: "Thank you God for ____." The first person fills in the blank with something that starts with the letter A. The next person fills in the blank with something that starts with the letter B. Continue going around the circle until you get to Z!

1. Who met Jesus while He was traveling?
2. What did these men want from Jesus?
3. Leprosy is a very painful skin disease. A person who has leprosy was called a leper. Lepers had to live by themselves because no one else in the town wanted to be catch leprosy from them. When Jesus told these men to show themselves to the priests, He was healing them of leprosy. How would you feel if Jesus healed you of leprosy?
4. What did only ONE of the TEN men do?
5. The one man that returned to thank God was a Samaritan. Samaritans were not seen as nice or clean people. A lot of people didn't like Samaritans. Isn't it interesting to notice that the ONLY person who thanked Jesus was a Samaritan. Sometimes we let ourselves get caught up in how people appear to be, what group their friends are in, or even what clothes they wear. We forget to look at the REAL person. What can you do to try to look for the REAL person all the time?
6. Make a list of three things you want to thank God for. Think of things you've never thanked Him for before!
